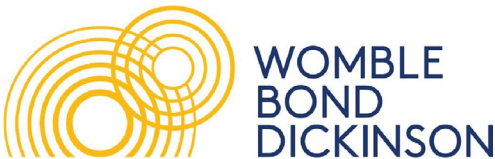
Cybersecurity: Meeting the Challenge of Cyberthreats to Intellectual Property
