In September, the [State Board of Accountancy sent out the following email reminder](#) to certificate holders about the CPE requirement for this reporting year. There are a few things we would like to highlight for you about the reporting period:

- Certificate holders have until December 31, 2019, to meet the CPE requirement.
- There is no grace or extension period to meet the requirement.
- If a certificate holder is short hours he/she should self-report to the State Board of Accountancy.
- The reference in the email to a “minimum of 10 CPE hours for every full quarter their credential is active” does not mean certificate holders have to get 10 hours every quarter. CPE can be taken anytime in the reporting cycle.
- CPE audits will be conducted at the end of the reporting year.

Senate Bill 19-155 has a provision that allows a nonresident certificate holder applying to renew, reactivate, or reinstate a certificate issued in Colorado that demonstrates compliance, through an attestation submitted with an application, with the continuing education requirements for renewal, reactivation, or reinstatement of a certificate in the state in which the certificate holder’s principal place of business is located is deemed to have satisfied the continuing education requirement in this state. The ability to attest a certificate holder has met the CPE requirement in the state in which the principal place of business is located will be available in the next reporting year.
